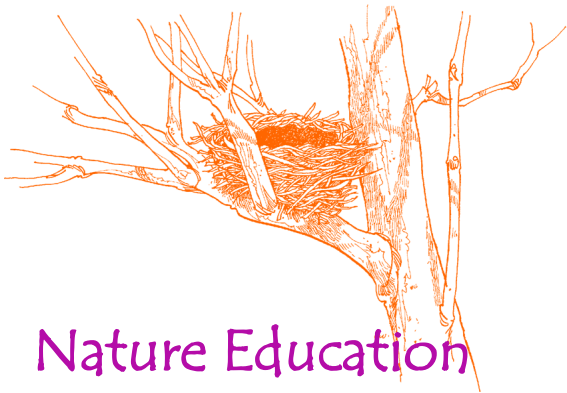

Branching Activities for Pollinators and Their Host Plants



- ◇ **Create Your Own Pollinator Garden**– Create your own garden and try to attract your favorite species of pollinator! When creating your garden ask yourself these questions: What kind of pollinators do I want to attract? Do I want my flowers to bloom all year round or just for a season? Are the flowers I am planting safe for my family and pets?
