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Try out the Flying Fish Catch Game

- This is a perfect game for 2 or more players! Cut up sponges into fish shapes and grab a tray or bucket. One person should hold the bucket or tray and stand far away from the other players who have the fish sponges. The players with the fish sponges should take turns trying to throw them into the bucket! Add water to the sponges or bucket on a hot day to cool off.

Make sticky fish wall art!

- Draw an outline of a fish on a piece of large paper like chart paper then go outdoors on a nature hike. On your hike collect leaves, sticks, or anything else you like and bring it back inside to your fish. Using tape or glue use your nature items to decorate your fish! You can make your fish colorful or even try and create a pattern!



Participate in a trash clean up!

- Visit a beach, lake, or stream and bring a trash bag with you. As you walk around and enjoy nature, pick up as much trash as you can. This not only helps the ecosystem as a whole but prevents pollution from getting into the water and harming the fish that live there!
