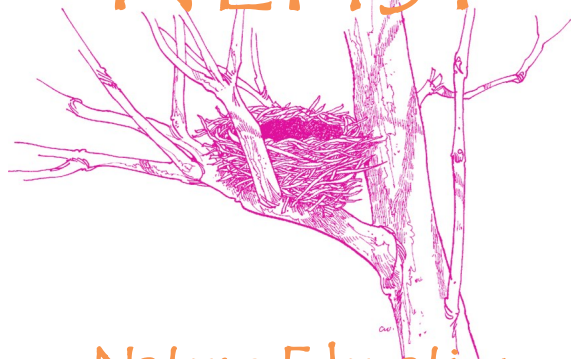

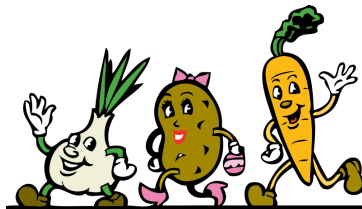

Regrow vegetables like potatoes or green onions directly from scraps. This reinforces sustainable living concepts by recycling and reusing!

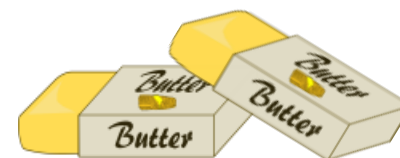
