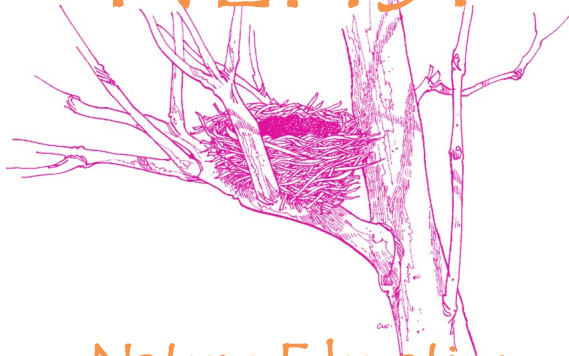

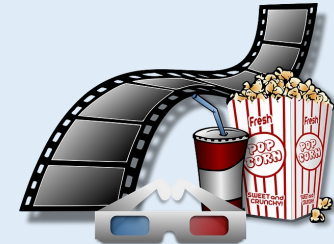
Scientific Illustration Journal

Wildlife Explorers

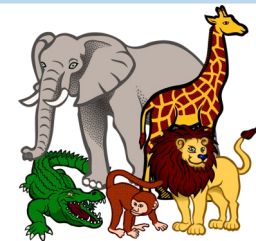
Focuses more on animal groups as well as zookeeping from the San Diego Zoo.
