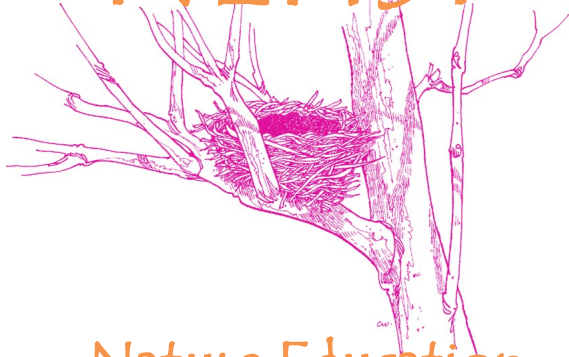

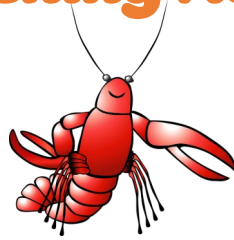

Crayfish Catcher

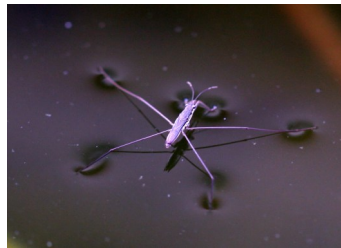

Have you ever wondered how those little bugs are able to keep themselves on top of the water? Try this fun STEM activity to see how they stay afloat!

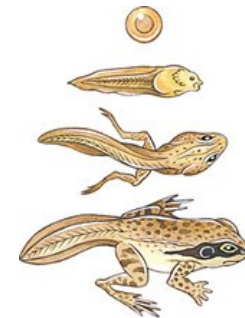
